After that Santa Sabina scored a lucky goal to even things out.


Half time came and the score was 2-3(9) Portmarnock to 1-5(8) Santa Sabina , tight but Portmarnock was up by one!

## Ole Gunnar Solskjaer and his time as Manchester United Manager

This article winds back the years and re-lives Ole gunnars managerial time at Manchester United.



On December 19th 2018 Ole was appointed as caretaker manager of Manchester United following the dismissal of Jose Mourinho.

### Ole Gunnar's time as caretaker manager

Ole was caretaker manager from December to March. This time period is remembered fondly by united fans. He won 14 of his 19 games in charge, only losing once to PSG. One of Ole's more memorable moments as caretaker was a comeback win in Paris against PSG where his side came back from 2 goals down to win the tie on away goals on aggregate. Romelu Lukaku scored and Marcus Rashford scored an emphatic penalty in the dying seconds of the game to send the red devils through to the Champions League quarter finals.

## Appointed as first team manager

Following the teams heroics in Paris,Ole was appointed as first team manager and signed a 3 year contract. From March 2019 to November 2021 (ole sacked) there were many ups and downs but in general Ole's time as Man United manager was positive. Memorable moments include the comeback in Paris, positive showing versus Messi and Barcelona in the quarter finals and led them to a successive top three finish in the Premier League, reaching four semi-finals and one Europa

League final, but without securing any silverware. November 2021: Sacked after a series of poor results, most notably a heavy defeat at Watford.

#### **Final Summary**

Oles' time as Manchester manager ended sourly due to him losing control of his dressing room due to some players like Paul Pogba and their very high egos. In my opinion as a Man United fan I think since the famous Sir Alex Ferguson, Ole gunnar was the best manager and got the most out of an average team. Other managers include Louis Van Gaal, Erik Ten Hag, Jose Mourinho, David Moyes and Ralf Ragnick. I think Ole was the only one of these managers who created a positive relationship with both the fans and players and also managed some fantastic results like the comeback against PSG and multiple wins against Pep Guardiola's Manchester City.

AFTER A FEW HARD SEASONS, RAPHINHA EXPLODED IN THE 2024-25 SEASON, SCORING 34 GOALS AND ASSISTING 22, WITH AN AVERAGE PERFORMANCE OF 8.1, HELPING HIS BARCELONA SIDE SECURE THE LA LIGA TITLE, COPA DEL RAY AND THE SUPER COPA, PICKING UP THE CHAMPIONS LEAGUE TOP SCORER AND LA LIGA PLAYER OF THE SEASON. 

On the 21st of September 2025, Brody Grant took his final bow as Ponyboy Curtis in The Outsiders musical on Broadway. The Tony and Grammy nominee has been part of the cast since the pre Broadway world premiere in La Jolla Playhouse in 2023. The actor then kept with the role and made his Broadway debut in March of 2024 in the Bernard B. Jacobs Theatre.

As Brody stepped out into the theatre to do his final walk, up he was met with a standing ovation from his fans. During the song "Stay Gold" Brody's co star Sky Lakota-Lynch who plays Johnny Cade started to cry whilst he said his last lines of the show: "There's still a lot of time to make yourself what you want, Ponyboy. There's still a whole lotta good in the world. Tell Dally, I don't think he knows." Fans believe Sky became so emotional during this moment because the lyrics sound like he is actually giving Brody some advice for when he moves on from the show. When Brody took his last bow with his cast mates, he pulled out a cap from his back pocket. It was later revealed that it was his Grandpa's hat so his Grandpa could have something from the show and so he could feel more connected with his family on the day. A few days later the star posted a picture of the cap captioned "For Grandpa" which loosely references "For Johnny" in the original show.

Now that Brody has left the cast, his understudy Trevor Wayne will step into the role as Ponyboy but this strikes worry in the fandom as Trevor faces backlash for allegedly being kicked out of college because he sexually assaulted a girl in his course. Now that this information has come to the surface, fans on TikTok have found posts that Trevor has liked and or commented on that are transphobic, homophobic, and racist. The Outsiders fandom are torn in two over this situation and don't know what they should do about this matter.




One fan on TikTok comments that "we have to forgive Trevor if we still support the original actors of Ponyboy (C. Other fans are completely repulsed by Trevor's actions and have now started to sensor his name when talking of him on social media.



# SUSPECT CHRISTIAN BRUECKNER FREED

The main suspect in the disappearance of Madeleine McCann has called for the prosecutor, who has accused him of the three-year-old's murder in 2007, to "stop this witch hunt" against him. German national Christian Brueckner made the trip to speak to prosecutor Hans Christian Wolters, days after being released from prison where he served a seven-year rape sentence. As part of his release, Brueckner has had to surrender his passport and be fitted with an ankle tag. The 49-year-old suspect told Sky News he wanted the prosecutor to give him his "life back" and that he still did not "feel freed".

Others believe that nobody should die for a political opinion no matter how immoral the belief is.

#### Related people:

There's a lot of famous people in America that are related to politics but I'm going to be mainly mentioning Donald Trump and Charlie Kirk.

#### Donald trump:

Trump is the president of the United States currently. He had a campaign in 2016 where he beat his opponent Hillary Clinton. Now he's currently president as he was voted in instead of Kamala Harris. He is right wing (he resides with political views from the right) and is seen as a leader to the right party because of his position. People that are on the left do not like him, for his political views and that he has a reputation for being very hypocritical, examples of his opinions are such: Antiabortion, a quote for this opinion is quote The answer is that there has to be some form of punishment. anti-LGBT, trump has many anti trans quotes: one misgendering Caitlyn Jenner and calling her her deadname. "On Caitlyn Jenner. I knew him a little bit when Bruce was a great athlete." Trump confidently uses wrong words in speeches, some of the left wing think this is dementia from his age(79), some of which make little sense such as "making the mice transgender" sources believe he was meant to say transgenic or something of the sort.

The right wing agree with some of his opinions and that is why they voted for him and most people that have voted for him excuse the 34 felonies he has (there is evidence from interviews that the majority response to "why would you vote on a man with so many felonies" is that they don't believe those felonies happened), felonies such as falsifying business records and sexual assault are felonies he has been accounted liable for. The right wing also agreed with Trump's tariffs until they caused the cost of items in stores to rise.

Since Trump has become president many left wing believe that he's becoming a dictator and there are incidents that back up this claim. Incidents such as his colleagues having ABC take down talk shows for speaking ill of Trump or his policies, painting over a road dedicated to people that fought for LGBT rights, having the letters T and Q removed from the stonewall monument in New York, and having the statue of Donald trump and jeffery Epstein holding hands as it is believed that the two were friends and this isn't good for trump as Epstein is a convicted pedophile.

1 tbsp golden syrup 285ml cream 200g icing sugar Sprig of holly for decoration

Lay a sheet of baking parchment on a work surface. When the cake is ready, tip it onto the parchment, peel off the lining paper, then roll the cake up from its longest edge with the

step 3

paper inside. Leave to cool.

step 4 To make the icing, melt the butter and dark chocolate together in a bowl over a pan of hot water. Take from the heat and stir in the golden syrup and 5 tbsp double cream. Beat in the icing sugar until smooth.

corners. Bake for 10 mins.

step 5 Whisk the remaining double cream until it holds its shape. Unravel the cake, spread the cream over the top, scatter over the crushed extra strong mints, if using, then carefully roll up again into a log.

step 6 Cut a thick diagonal slice from one end of the log. Lift the log on to a plate, then arrange the slice on the side with the diagonal cut against the cake to make a branch. Spread the icing over the log and branch (don't cover the ends), then use a fork to mark the icing to give the effect of tree bark. Scatter with unsifted icing sugar to resemble snow, and decorate with holly.
